## Travel Directions to Synod Office



The Synod Office is at the rear of St James's United Reformed Church, a large stone building with a spire, which stands on the corner of a small lane. Look for the *blue* door behind the chimney at 4 College Lane, and press the *intercom* for entry.

**By Metro or Bus** [www.nexus.org.uk](http://www.nexus.org.uk)

Five minutes' walk from **Haymarket**.

From the bus station, turn *left* and head briefly north to the Metro station.

From the Metro station, turn *half left* to reach the corner of Northumberland Street with St Mary's Place and travel about 300 yards east, crossing John Dobson Street. Turn *right* into College Street, then first *left* into College Lane.

### By Train

There is a taxi rank outside Newcastle Central Station, or you can follow the yellow Metro signs to the right of the main exit, and descend to the Central Station Metro Station. You will need change to get a ticket from the machine to Haymarket (currently £1.70 single, £2.90 DaySaver), then descend again to Platform 2 and travel two stops.

### By Air

Metro also runs from Newcastle International Airport. A glass corridor connects it to the airport, which may be reached by looking for the yellow Metro signs to the left of the main exit. You will need change to get a ticket from the machine to Haymarket (currently £3.30 single, £5.00 DaySaver). Travel eleven stops.




## By Car

From the North, South and West, leave the A167(M) Central Motorway at the second junction, and take the B1309 Durant Road towards the City Centre. Turn *right* into College Street at traffic lights, and *right* into College Lane when you reach a car park (currently £1.50 per hour/£3.00 per day).



From the East, approach along the B1307 Sandyford Road, and *left* into College Street, *left* again into College Lane and into the car park.



Please note: there is no right turn into College Street from St Mary's Place heading east, so you have to go past it and turn back at the next roundabout.

If the College Street car park is full, there is also one on Durant Road, and a large multi-storey on the western section of Northumberland Road.
