Vision

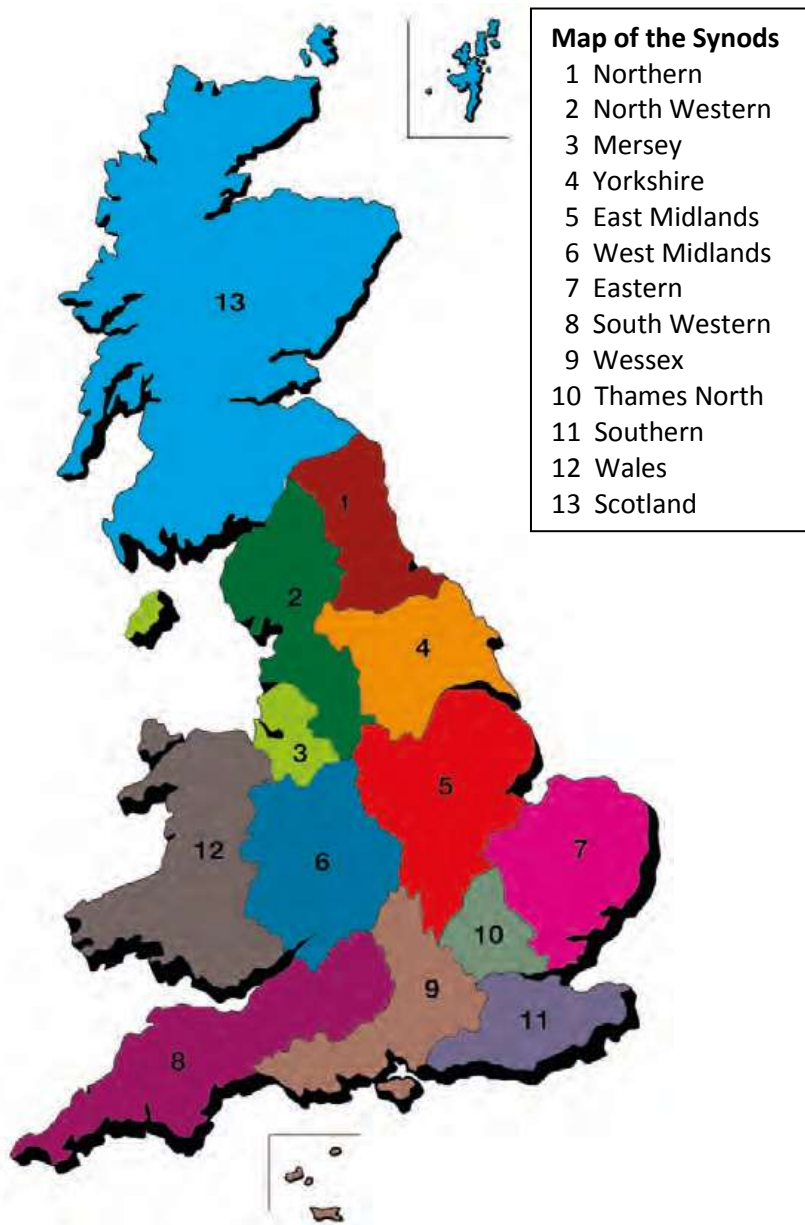
The Synod's vision is, during the ten years to 2020, to be part of a growing lively church bearing much fruit in the North East, by enabling local churches to be lively, informed and effective in being the church in their local setting and Synod to be an expression of the Church at regional level in the light of Vision 2020.

Organisation

The United Reformed Church is organised into 13 synods. The Northern Synod brings together 70 local churches and mission projects in the North East and part of North Yorkshire. The churches are gathered into 13 mission partnerships for mutual support and joint activities.

The Synod meets on a Saturday in March and October, and is chaired by a Moderator, assisted by a Clerk.

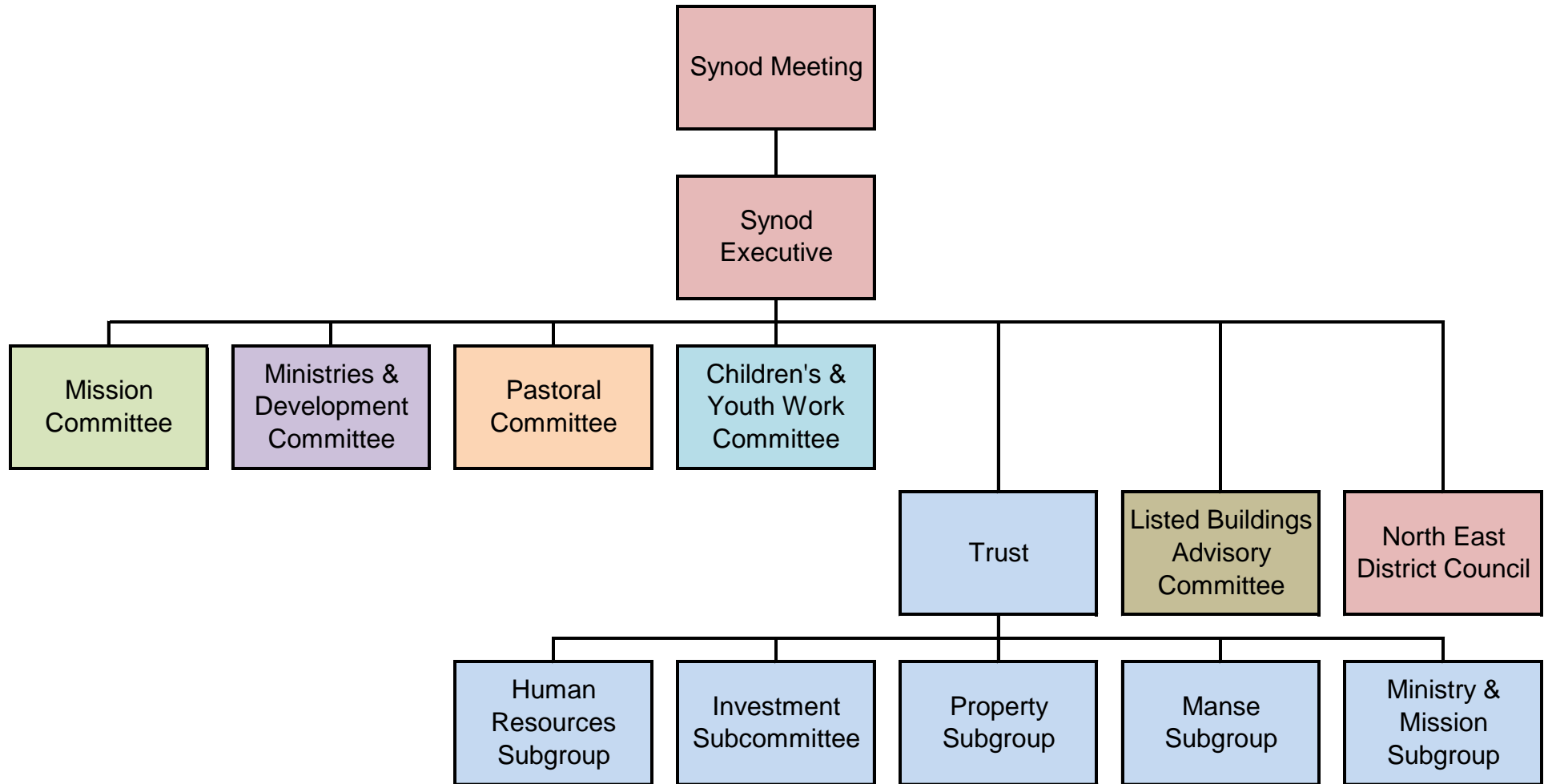
